Charter Public School: Public schools that are independently run and granted greater flexibility to meet children's needs in return for stringent accreditation accountability. Open-enrollment charter schools generally must accept any student who applies, subject to provisions in their charter contract. These schools are governed by a private, non-profit board of directors. Traditional Public School: Public schools that are run by the State Board of Education. Enrollment acceptance is usually based on a student's address within a defined geographical boundary area.
