Economically Disadvantaged: Students that are eligible for free or reduced-priced lunches at school or are eligible for other public assistance as reported by districts. For other reasons why a student may be identified as an economically disadvantaged student, click [here](#).

Emergent Bilingual/English Learners: Students whose primary language is one other than English and who are in the process of acquiring English. The terms Emergent Bilingual (EB), English Language Learner (ELL), English Learner (EL), and Limited English Proficient (LEP) are often used interchangeably.

Special Education: Students who receive special instruction and related developmental, corrective, supportive, or evaluative services for the current school year as reported by districts and on their STAAR test answer documents.

Student Enrollment by Ethnicity: The percentage of students who are identified as belonging to one of the following groups: African American, Hispanic, White, American Indian, Asian, Pacific Islander, and two or more races.

Total Student Enrollment: The total number of student attending a school or district (early childhood education through grade 12) on the last Friday each October. This number is reported once every year.
